



With music, magic and a stirring narration by Lotte herself, Lotte That Silhouette Girl tells the tale of one of animations' biggest influencers, Lotte Reiniger.

Lotte Reiniger's beautiful 1926 silhouette animation, The Adventures of Prince Achmed, brings to life magical tales from the Arabian Nights. The earliest surviving animated feature film, preserved in the BF1 National Archive, it has been hailed as one of the world's most innovative and influential animations. Handsome young Prince Achmed is brave and eager for adventure, so when the most powerful sorcerer in the world challenges him to fly a magic horse.



From creating your character to setting them off on their journey, Writing For Animation teaches students about the fundamentals of storytelling.



Short Films: Sci-Fi



Recommended ages: All Ages Running Time: 105 mins












