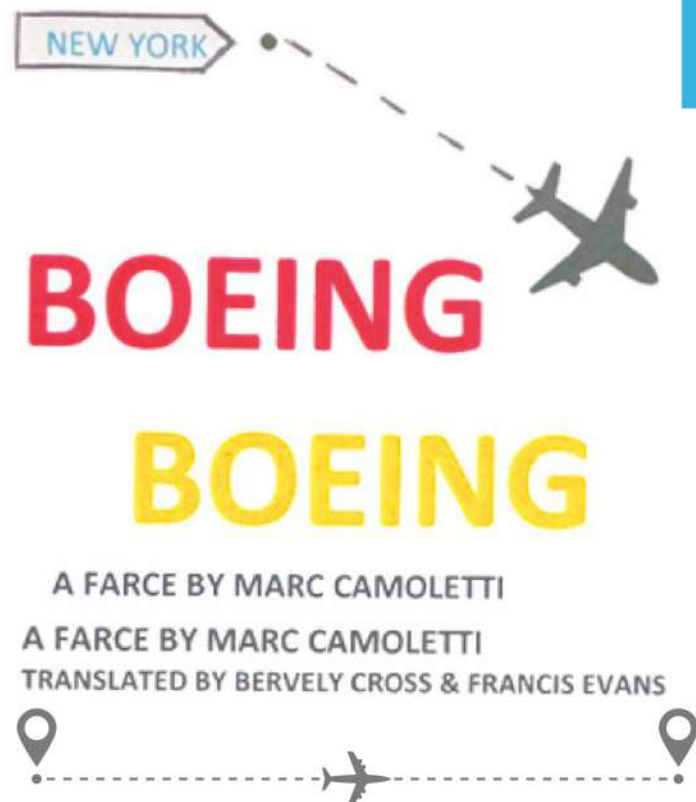


## Nenagh Youth Theatre

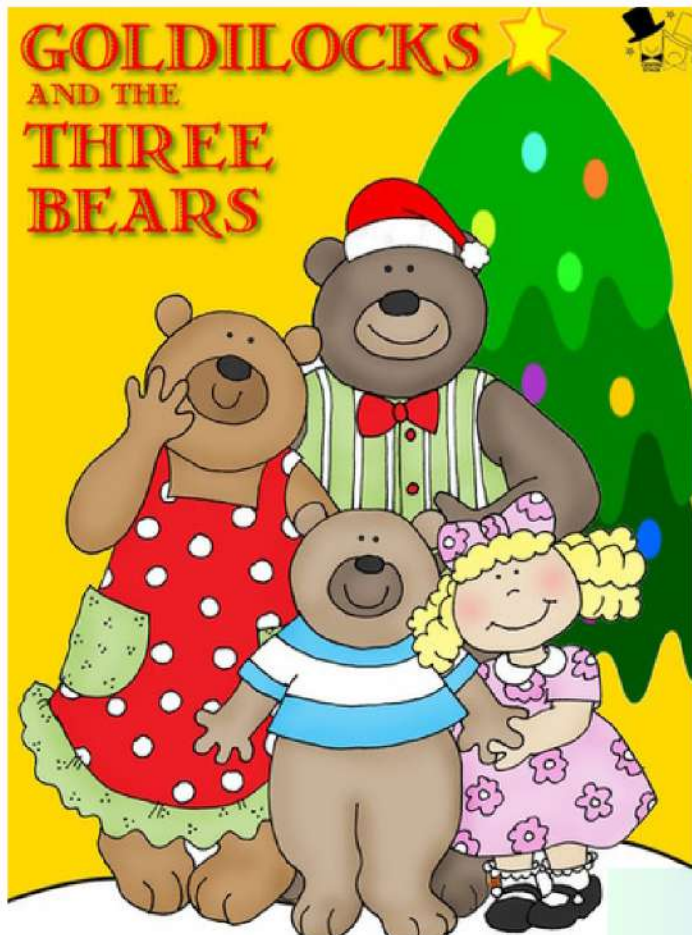

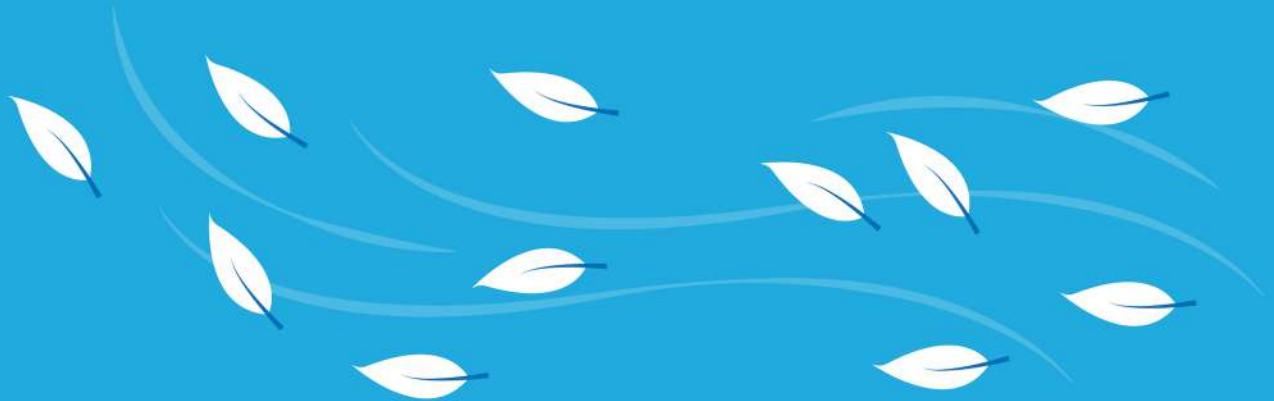
